HyRAP® Hot Mix Asphalt has now been used in multiple cities, municipalities, and by Caltrans in Southern California and has emerged as an excellent example of high-quality street construction, completed with less cost and fewer impacts on residents.

These cities have primarily been using a two-step process. The overlay material, **HyRAP**® hot mix asphalt (**HyRAP**®), is applied over an Asphalt Rubber binder, which is a combination of paving grade asphalt and crumb rubber derived from scrap tires, followed by a cover aggregate, referred to as ARAM. The ARAM provides a crack resistant, waterproofing membrane. The **HyRAP**® cap course provides a smooth riding, esthetically pleasing surface. This two-step process is referred to as **HyRAM**™. BENEFITS OF USING Hyrap® HOT MIX ASPHALT (Hyrap®) ON AN ASPHALT RUBBER AGGREGATE MEMBRANE (ARAM) = Hyram™

1. COST EFFICIENCY:

HyRAM™ is saving money for cities that are using it in place of full reconstruction for damaged streets. In fact, the City of Montebello found that even the worst streets previously requiring full reconstruction, rated as low as a 10 PCI, can be rehabilitated with **HyRAM**™, saving both money and time.

2. DURABILITY AND PERFORMANCE:

HyRAM™ projects are standing up over time. A recent review of a 10-year old project in Fort Wayne, Indiana showed that **HyRAP**® has held up well, even in the harsh freeze/thaw conditions of Indiana. Closer to home, in Montebello, where streets were repaved more than 3 years ago, the streets continue to look new and drive smooth.

3. FEWER CONSTITUENT IMPACTS:

In addition to saving money, using \mathbf{HyRAM}^{TM} limits the driving and dust impacts to neighborhoods. Traditional grinding of existing pavements produces substantial dust in neighborhoods. Additionally, residents and businesses get their streets returned to them much quicker when using \mathbf{HyRAM}^{TM} compared to traditional rehabilitation strategies, eliminating days of disruption in neighborhoods.
